Stettler's Canada Day Parade

Rules and Regulations

In order to ensure a safe and rewarding parade day for both the participants and the audience, we will enforce the following rules and regulations. Please read the following documentation carefully and ensure that all members associated with your entry are familiar with these rules and regulations.

The parade route is 2.8 km in length and will take approximately 1 -1.5 hours to complete. All participants must ensure their entries maintain a steady and consistent speed on the route so as not to interfere with the constant motion of the parade and afford no gaps for spectators. Entries must not deviate from the established parade route unless directed by a parade official or R.C.M.P. officer.

The Stettler Canada Day Parade will run rain or shine.

- 1. All participants enter the Canada Parade at their own risk. The Town of Stettler, Stettler Regional Board of Trade and Community Development, staff, and volunteers assume no liability.
- 2. All parade entries, including livestock, must provide a copy of their own liability insurance with the parade application. Insurance must include the Stettler Regional Board of Trade and Community Development and the Town of Stettler as additional insureds. A minimum of \$1,000,000 public liability is required. If a tow vehicle is owned by a different entity other than the applicant, the tow vehicle's owner must provide an additional insurance policy.
- 3. The Stettler Board of Trade reserves the right to refuse access to the Parade by any entry deemed unsuitable or dangerous that interferes with the progress of the parade or any other reason deemed appropriate.
- 4. All entries must be at the marshaling area (62 Street- Recreation Road- Access from 44th Avenue ONLY) any time between 9:15 am and 9:45 am. Please arrange to have your float decorated before arriving at the marshaling area. The left lane must remain open. Members of the Parade Committee will assign parade positions. See map for reference. INSERT ASSEMBLY MAP In the package
- 5. For safety reasons, candy or advertising items may only be handed out along the parade route. Under no circumstances will throwing items be allowed. To ensure the comfort and safety of all spectators viewing the parade, water guns or apparatus that shoot water or other materials are strictly prohibited.
- 6. All drivers must have a valid driver's license and may be asked to present their license when they arrive at the marshaling area. All entries must always allow the driver a 180-degree view of the route. All entries, detached or otherwise, should directly communicate with the driver. Drivers of motorized vehicles must be at least 16 years of age. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 7. Protective equipment, especially helmets, must be worn for motorcycling, rollerblading, biking, and s skateboarding, regardless of age. Helmets must also be worn by youth under the age of 16 for livestock participants.
- 8. All units carrying people must be equipped with adequate restraining devices that can reasonably be considered capable of stopping someone from falling from the unit.

- 9. Adequate supervision of children and youth must be provided, prior to and during the parade. Suggested 1 adult to 8 children.
- 10. All animals must be treated humanely and fed and watered before and after the parade. Entrants are responsible for ensuring the assembly area is clean upon departure.
- 11. All decorative materials must be fire retardant, and no flammable materials may be carried on the float, in vehicles, or on people. It is strongly suggested that all entries be equipped with a fire extinguisher kept within reach of the driver/operator.
- 12. In an emergency, parade participants must move to the right of the parade route to allow emergency vehicles clear, unhindered access. No smoking, prohibited drugs, cannabis, or alcoholic beverages are allowed in the assembly area or on parade entries. No amount of alcohol, cannabis, and/or banned drugs may be consumed before entering the assembly location.
- 13. Participants who parade officials believe have consumed alcohol, cannabis, or prohibited drugs before or during the parade will be removed from the parade and dealt with by local authorities as required.
